Stem-cell hope for coronary care

Blood vessels made from bone marrow have been successfully tested in sheep, paving the way for trials in humans. Similar implants could be used to help heart bypass patients. The vessels functioned normally for five weeks in the sheep. Scientists at the University of Buffalo, New York State, are now working to make them stronger and longer lasting. The team is using adult stem cells.
